CALL FOR HOST ORGANIZATIONS

"Universities for EU Projects' Culture" finances the traineeship of 140 students selected by a consortium of 8 major Italian universities to freely support host organizations with the following tasks:

- Submit a project proposal on behalf of the receiving organization;
- Develop an analysis of the company's funding needs and opportunities.

Participating organizations

Requirements to participate as host organization

- The receiving organisation can be any public or private organisation active in the labour market, for example:
 - o a public or private, a small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises);
 - o a public body at local, regional or national level;
 - a social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions;
 - o a research institute;
 - o a foundation;



Send



- o a school/institute/educational centre (at any level, from preschool to up-per secondary education, and including vocational education and adult education);
- o a non-profit organisation, association, NGO;
- o a body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services.
- o a Programme Country HEI awarded with an ECHE
- The receiving organizations must be based in one of the Erasmus + Programme Countries, with the exception of Italy (in order to respect the transnationally of the mobility):
 - O EU Countries: Austria, Greece, United Kingdom, Belgium, Ireland, Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Romania, Cyprus, Latvia, Slovakia, Croatia, Lithuania, Slovenia, Denmark, Luxembourg, Spain, Estonia, Malta, Sweden, Finland, Netherlands, Hungary, France, Poland, Germany, Portugal.
 - Non-EU Countries: Iceland, Turkey, Liechtenstein, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Norway.
- The following types of organisations are not eligible as receiving organisations for student traineeships: EU institutions and other EU bodies including specialised agencies (their exhaustive list is available on the website ec.europa.eu/institutions/index_en.htm); organisations managing EU programmes such as national agencies (in order to avoid a possible conflict of interests and/or double funding).

Role of the host organizations

- Provide students with necessary information and support to perform their tasks
- Agree and implement the contents of the mobility agreement
- Contribute to the dissemination of results

Timing

- Length of the mobility: between 2 and 3 months
- Period for the mobility: between 1st February and 31st October 2016







Procedure for the selection of host organizations

To become candidate as Receiving Organization please fill in the annex 1 and send it to f.zotta@europeanprojects.org by the 15th January 2016.

The matching between the 140 students and organizations will take into account profiles, technical skills, experiences, language skills, expectations and periods of preference. Selected organizations and students will receive a proposal of matching that will be free to accept or not.

Financial support for students

Participant students receive a grant between 430 EUR and 480 EUR according to the country of destination; travel costs, specific costs for participants with disabilities and language support costs are also paid by the project. Students are covered by insurance for workplace accidents and civil liability against third parties.

Receiving organizations don't receive financial support from the project.

Language support

Participants will have access to a language-learning portal developed by the European Commission before and during mobility.
